



Installing Edge Express on Mac

1. Make sure you have registered with The Edge and that you have a customer id that looks like this **paul17** and a password. If you don't know your password we can look it up for you. When registering please make sure password do not have any illegal characters in them like (*&^%)
2. Make sure there is no Edge Express folder in either your Downloads and Applications Folder, if there is delete them.
3. Go to your security and privacy settings under system preferences



4. **For Operating systems other than Sierra.** In the general tab select ANYWHERE under Allow Apps downloaded from section. (you may have to unlock and submit your mac password to get to this feature)



5. For Operating systems with Sierra. Your window will look like this, just select the App Store and Identified developers



6. Go to your firewall settings and turn it off, if it was on

7. Go to our website www.theedgephoto.com.au and click on the ORDER ONLINE button

8. Click on the apple support link and Download the patch from the Apple Website and Install


10. This download will end up in your downloads folder as edge express.zip




11. Double Click on the edge express.zip, this will create another edge express folder



12. Drag the Edge Express folder (not the .zip folder) into your Applications folder




13. Open the Edge Express Folder




14. For Non Sierra users continue on here, for Sierra Users go to number **21**


15. Double Click the Edge Express App




16. You will get a warning “edge express is an application downloaded from the internet, are you sure you want to open it, click open




17. You will then get the “Who are you” login, enter your customer ID




18. You will then get the “Enter your password” box, enter your password




19. The Next box will ask you “where to store project info” don’t change anything and click OK




20. The Edge Express Program will then open




21. **For Sierra Users**, Right click on the Edge Express App in your applications folder and select "Show package contents"




22. Open Contents > MacOS > and double click on the Edge Express exec file




23. You will get a warning, Click Open




24. Enter your Customer ID




25. Enter your Password

27. The Edge Express Program will then open up. You will see another window on your desktop with some text in it, don't close this window, by doing so you will shutdown The Edge Express program



28. Your final step it to drag that Edge Express exec file **next** to your trash bin for a quick launch of Edge Express. (You will find this file in step 21 and 22)
